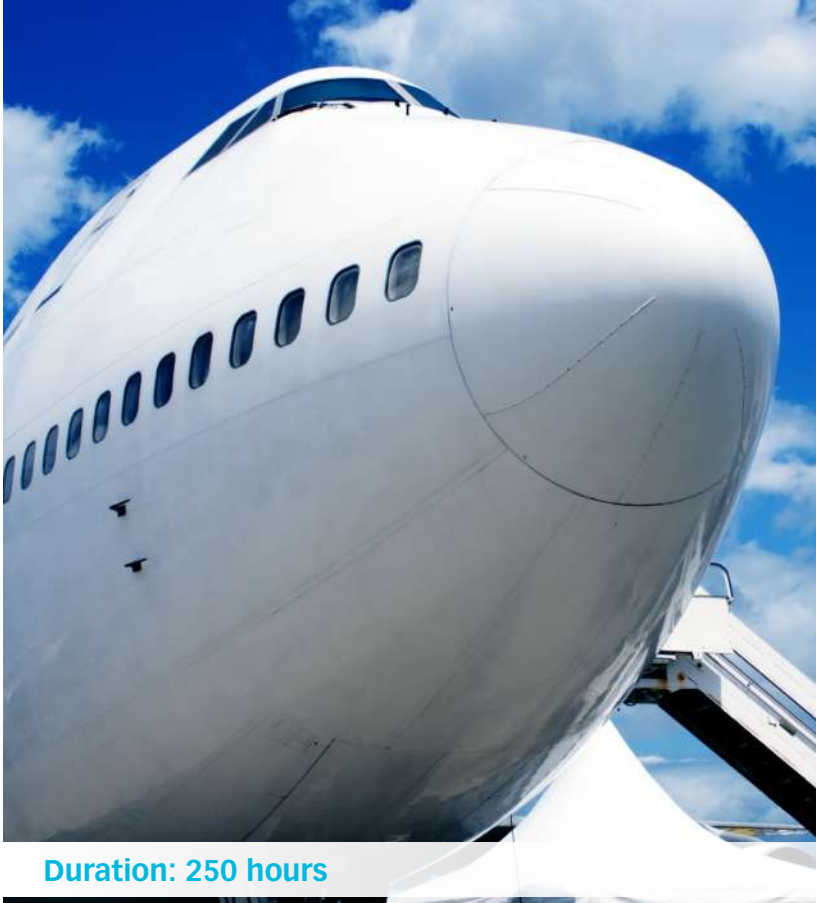

Entry Requirements

- Five HKDSE subjects at Level 2 or above, including English and Chinese Languages, or equivalent with one year's relevant work experience; or
- Five HKCEE subjects at Grade E/Level 2 or above, including English and Chinese Languages, or equivalent with two years' relevant work experience; or
- Completion of a QF Level 3 programme, or equivalent, with one year's work experience or currently employed; or
- Relevant RPL qualification(s) at QF Level 3 or above.
- Mature applicants, i.e. those aged 21 or above with at least two years' relevant work experience, may also be accepted. Where appropriate, the applicant may be required to pass an entrance assessment, which can be in an oral and/or written form.
